Rendezvous: At 1030 in the vicinity of **Francis Scott Key Buoy** (red, white & blue nun - location: N39°13.45' W076°31.71'). The buoy marks the spot where the ship carrying Francis Scott Key, the author of "The Star-Spangled Banner", was anchored during the bombardment of Fort McHenry during the War of 1812.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between yellow flag on RC boat and Francis Scott Key Buoy or nearby government mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races) as changed below:

Course: Designated by letters displayed on RC boat, as further described in the Green Book Sailing Instructions and Region 2 Baltimore Harbor and Patapsco River Standard Racing Marks.

Finish: Between yellow flag on RC boat and Region 2 Baltimore Harbor and Patapsco River Standard Racing Mark "K" (G"23"). Course may be shortened at any designated course mark. Boats not finishing are requested to notify RC boat on VHF Channel 72.

Time Limit: 4 hours.

Protests: Protester should immediately notify RC boat upon finishing. Written protest forms must be postmarked by Tuesday 12 July 2011 to the contact listed above. Protester and protested will be notified of the time and place of the protest hearing.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7+ finishers. Awards will be presented at RCRA's Annual Awards Dinner in February 2012.

Other: Participants wishing a hard copy of class results should furnish a stamped, self-addressed envelope with their entry.
